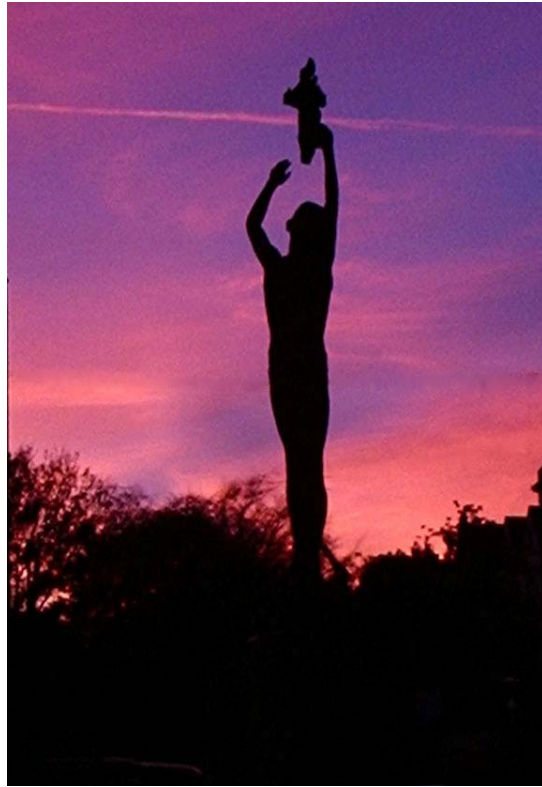

Postcard sent by Alexander Webb, from the Frontline in France to May Allen, 1916

Alec came home and married May. There are now 12 great-great-grandchildren



We Remember

(believed to be) William Warman married
Ethel Fassoms

Dover, 1911. They were killed during an air-raid in 1942



We Remember

Robert Kember married Nellie Ward
Dover, 1927. Robert's twin brother, Edward, died in 1918,
aged 24. Stephen Edward, front row, named after his uncle,
was killed in 1943, also aged 24



Survivors of the Great War

Robert Easton married Elsie Lund
Holy Trinity, Dover
27th December 1920

Bob's uncles, Harry and Eddie Crascall and his cousin, William Gatehouse, were killed in the Great War. Bob and Elsie now have great-great-great grandchildren still in Dover

We Remember

Percy Macdonnell married Emily
Thomas

St Andrew's, Buckland, 22nd
June 1929

Percy was killed in 1943, leaving
his wife and 3 daughters





We Remember

James Wilkieson, married Ada Dawkings
Christchurch, Dover, Christmas Eve, 1938

James and his brother Andrew were killed on the same day in
1941



A War-Time Wedding - WWII

Alfred Webb married Vera Easton

St Mary's Church, Dover, 16th July 1942

Alfie is named after his uncle, killed in 1917



New Hope – the Post-War Generation
Michael Webb married Carole-Louise Piqué
St Mary's, Dover, 10th August 1968
They have 4 daughters and 6 grand-children
